I am writing to give my absolute support for the two products of Laurie Tandrup of Snuglbuds, Inc. We use the Travelbud and the Butterfly pillow consistently in our Neonatal Intensive care Unit at Sunnybrook and Women's College Health Sciences Center in Toronto, Ont.


The Travelbud has on numerous occasions allowed a premature infant to be discharged home at an appropriate time and in a safe manner. Without the Travelbud, either the discharge would be held up as the infant was not probing (oxygen saturation) well enough in his car seat and therefore he would not be considered safe to be allowed to go home. I also encourage the parents to use the Travelbud at home for any upright sitting positions.

With the Butterfly pillow, we use it in our Intensive care unit for improved positioning of the premature infant. I also use it for infants who have positional torticollis, positional plagiocephaly (flattening of the skull), VP shunts due to hydrocephalus, Cerebral palsy and for the visually impaired infants. These infants would use the pillow both in the hospital and at home as a therapeutic intervention.

Both these products are extremely beneficial and they fulfill many therapeutic requirements that many of these infants need.
